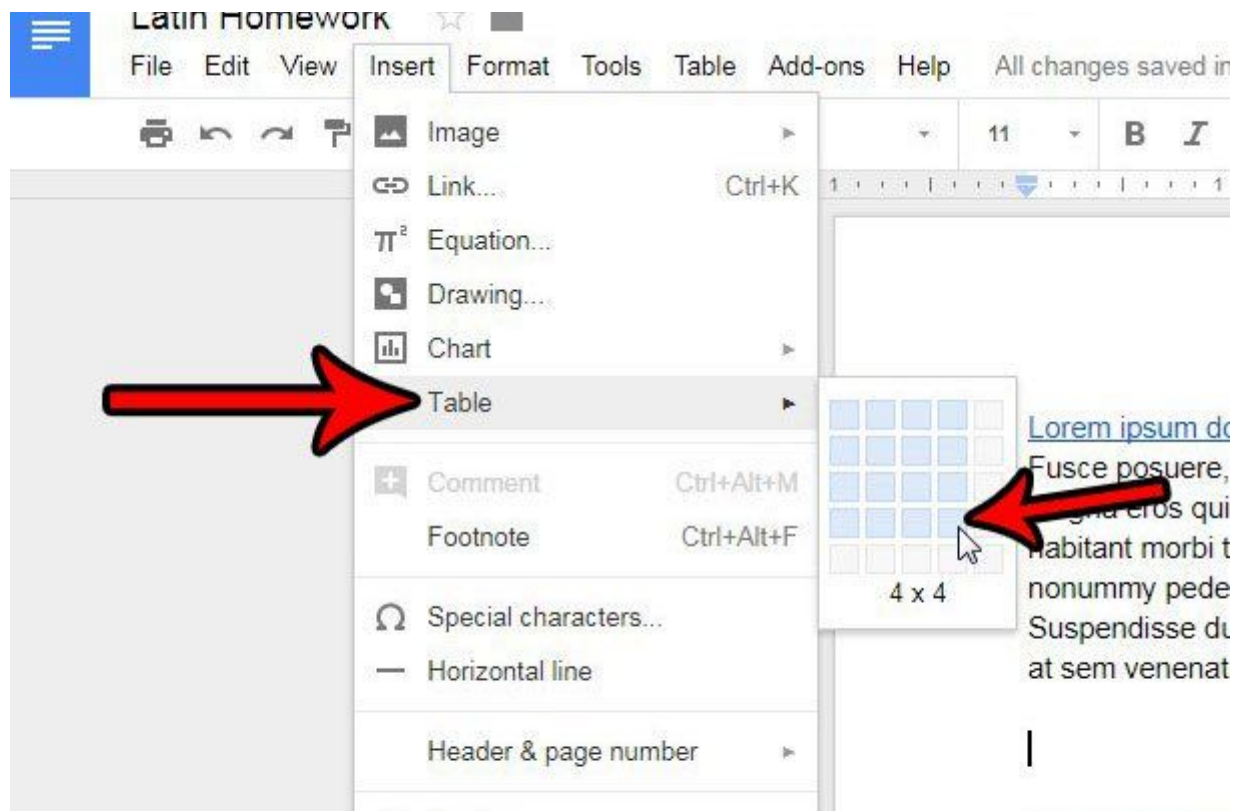

(Click the link to refresh your learning.)** For two of them, you will need to find an actual quote from the text; for the other two, you can simply write your own sentence about what is happening in this chapter.

The only visual requirements are that YOU are the primary figure in the photo and that you are representing the sentence.

### How this will be graded:

- Two of the sentences are quoted directly from Chapter 24 text
- The other sentences are about Chapter 24 and are accurate
